2. Proposed new models for providing and reimbursing healthcare (including the expansion of value-based purchasing and payment bundling, and the development of Accountable Care Organizations and other new models);
3. New transparency and quality requirements for skilled nursing facilities;
4. Initiatives to increase the size and enhance the education of the healthcare work force; and
5. New enforcement tools and penalty provisions.
